Birmingham Locks Down Again

We hope that you safely received our mid-week update via Schoolcomms, designed to keep you updated with the latest information from Chad Vale. There is no major update since Wednesday's mail and we've very happily welcomed 3Chad back into school along with Mrs Wood and Miss Dowd. Mrs Mohr continues to recover well and we are hoping to see her back in school on Monday. Children who attend the Hive are also due to return on Monday and Miss Larcombe and Miss Mohr are looking forward to seeing them again.

You will hopefully be aware of the current lock-down rules in Birmingham that are running alongside the national lock-down rules. If you are unsure or confused here is a brief summary:

- 'Rule of 6'- you must **not** meet up in groups where there are more than 6 people (national rules)
- If you are meeting with anyone you do not live with, you must maintain 2m social distance (national rules)
- FOR PEOPLE LIVING IN BIRMINGHAM/SOLIHUL/SANDWELL: You **MUST NOT** meet people you do not live with either inside or outside (unless they are your support bubble)

Whilst we understand these rules are inconvenient we would urge all Chad Vale parents to be aware of them and to follow them accordingly. This may mean having to postpone any parties planned until a time in the future when it is safer to do this, or to arrange safer ways to meet up with friends and family (e.g. virtually using Zoom /Facetime/phone).

We are working very hard in school to keep everyone as safe as we can, but all this hard work could be easily undone by the actions of Chad Vale families outside of school.

Educational Psychologist Telephone Helpline for Parents and Carers

Running until October half-term

Do you as a parent or carer feel that you need someone to talk to about your child during the return to school phase?

Birmingham Educational Psychology Service is providing a telephone helpline for any parents or carers of children in Birmingham, who feel they would benefit from a consultation with a psychologist to support them with any concerns arising at this time, for them or their families.

Areas of concern you may wish to discuss could include:

- Supporting you to support your child as they return to school.
- Concerns around the impact of the school shut down, and the return to school, on your children and family.
- How best to look after yourself so you can support your children.

The concerns can be related to school or family life.

You will be offered an initial telephone consultation of 30 minutes with a psychologist and a potential follow up session of another 30-minute consultation at a later date. These will be Monday-Friday, within standard working hours. The helpline will be running until Friday 23rd October 2020.

- The telephone number you would like to be contacted on.
- The name of your child's school.
- Any times and dates you are **not** available for a consultation.
- Whether an interpreter is required for you to access this service.

We will aim to get back to you within 2 working days to confirm a time and date for your consultation.

This service will, **as far as possible**, be confidential.
