QUESTIONS ABOUT KEY STAGE 1 TESTS

There have been a number of questions towards the end of this week about the Key Stage 1 tests. You may have heard in the media that one of the tests was released accidentally on the Internet and therefore the Government made the decision to withdraw the KS1 spelling, grammar and punctuation (SPAG) tests which are sat by Year 2 children. Chad Vale had been selected for early administration of the SPAG tests and our children had already sat the tests before the Government decision to withdraw them was announced. They all did very well indeed and we are very proud of them and all of the hard work that they put in this week. The children in Year 2 will still be required to sit the Reading and Maths papers and the phonics check for Year 1 children will be carried out later on in the year. Playing on a mini red sized court, using a tie breaker scoring system, 5 pairs of mixed doubles played off in 5 matches (called rubbers). The team that won the most rubbers won the match. Chad, led by the wonderful ground strokes of Naresh and Prasanna, raced out to a 2-0. Vale fought back in the 3rd rubber thanks to some impressive play by Suella, but it wasn't enough as the Chad Pair held on to secure an unassailable 3-0 lead. The Vale captain, Rio and his partner Umaymah restored some pride winning the 4th rubber but 5 Chad sealed an impressive 4-1 victory by winning the final rubber convincingly. The win secured another 3 points for Chad in the overall inter form competition.

Hockey

After the match was postponed due to bad weather before Easter, Y3 were finally able to play the final fixture in the 2016 inter form hockey competition on Thursday. A brace scored by Felix Cawsey and a goal by Ixmael Reyes were enough to defeat a competitive Vale team by 3 goals to 1. This victory saw Chad claim their sixth inter form point of the week and close the gap in the overall standing to just 2 points!!

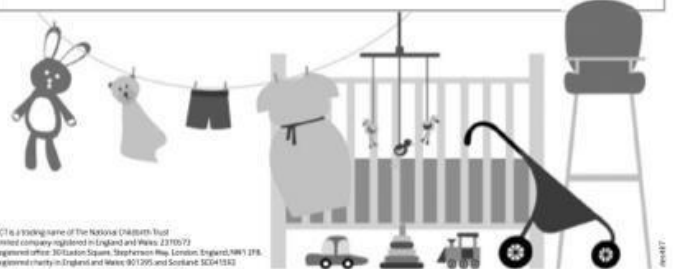
