

Search tools

Adding in 'for kids' at the end of a search term will allow you to only see content suitable for you.






Bookmarks or favourites

Hyperlink

A hyperlink is a word, phrase, or image that you can click on to jump to a new document or a new section, or even a new page on the web. Hyperlinks are found in nearly all Web pages, allowing users to click their way from page to page. Text hyperlinks are often blue and underlined, but don't have to be. When you move the cursor over a hyperlink, whether it is text or an image, the arrow should change to a small hand pointing at the link. When you click it, a new page or place in the current page will open.

When you create something, you own it. It is important to check who owns something on the internet, which could be a photo, a poem, some writing or a video. By digging deeper you should see the author, and ask if it is ok to use it.
