

This week we have been practising to read and spell words with the **a-e** and **e-e split digraphs** in. These are words where the 'e' at the end of the word makes the vowel that comes before it, say its letter name.

Below are a list of words that contain these letter combinations. Please ask your child to read a small selection of them each day as well as selecting some for them to spell. Remind them to say the word and then segment it into its individual sounds before they write it
