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Annual Parent Questionnaire 2016: please share your views!

It's the time of year where we'd like to collect your views on how the last 3 terms have gone for you and your child in our Annual Parent Questionnaire 2016. As in previous years, the questionnaire is online (but there are paper copies available from the office) and it should take no more than about 10 minutes to complete. The majority of the questions in this year's questionnaire are identical to the last few years and are taken from Ofsted's Parent View website. The official Ofsted version is available via their website and when we are due to be inspected next (in 2017) you will be asked to complete it online before the inspectors arrive (although you can submit your views at any time via the Ofsted Parent View website).

Our school version assists us in reviewing what has worked well this year and what we need to improve. The outcomes will be collated and analysed by senior leaders and shared with the teachers, governors and parents in early September. The responses will help to add crucial information to our school self evaluation, which then feeds into our School Development Plan - our short, medium and long term plans for ongoing improvement at Chad Vale.

Where you have more than one child at school, we are asking that you complete the survey for each child. This is because you may have different views or experiences in different classes when answering some of the questions. We've amended some of the answers slightly this year to help parents respond more accurately and (as in previous years) all respondents will be entered into a prize draw to win a £50 shopping voucher, kindly provided by our PPTA.

We welcome your honest feedback and in the past few years have initiated a number of changes in school as a direct result of the responses on the questionnaire. Please do include your name for the competition entry. This also allows us the opportunity to discuss your responses in more detail if we need to and will help us to respond personally to any questions, comments or compliments.

If you return it to her, she will enter the information online on your behalf so that it is included in the analysis. We'd also like to thank you in advance for taking the time to complete it - together we can make our school even better than it already is!

Chad Vale Chess Success

On Thursday 9th June, two teams from Chad Vale travelled to St Patrick's Catholic Primary School for their annual invitation chess tournament. Chad Vale were the under 9 holders and had won the under 9 section for the last four years. The under 11s had never won the competition outright but did share the trophy in 2013.

The under 9 team were in a very tough section and never lost a match scoring 1 win and 2 draws with a total of 8 points out of 12. Unfortunately they were just pipped by Balsall Common who scored 9 points out of 12 and went on to contest the final. This meant that Chad Vale were in the play-off for 3rd and 4th place. They drew that match as well but won third place due to a process called board count.

The under 11 team were in a section of three teams because one school pulled out at the last minute. However, they won both games to qualify for the final. This was against St Patrick's, who were the holders and had won the tournament twice in the last four years. Chad Vale convincingly won the final 4-2 to bring the trophy to Chad Vale.

Every player in each team won at least 1 match with Zayan Jamil winning all 4 games in the under 9s and Nam Anh Nyugen winning all 3 in the under 11s. Dylan Kular was also unbeaten in the under 11s, winning 2 games and drawing 1.

The other players were Hugo Rose, Ismaeel Hussein and Lucas Parkes in the under 9 team and Prasanna Sivakumar, Emily Town, Sarbaz Bangash and Max Carter in the under 11s.

Yet again a fantastic effort showing the depth of chess talent at Chad Vale.

N.B. Next year the arrangements for chess will be different. There will be no teaching in curriculum time but there will be three after-school club sessions on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. There has been a good response and the clubs are now full. If anyone else is interested, collect a form from Miss Green in the office, fill it in and your child will be placed on the waiting list.
